P = **Prime** – the primary order of notes around which the piece is built

I = **Inversion** – a mirror image upside down of the intervals of the Prime form

R = **Retrograde** – the notes of each Prime form, but in reverse order

RI = **Retrograde-Inversion** – the intervals of the Prime form both upside-down and backward.

Numbers 0 to 11 after each: How many half steps above the prime note each row or column is. The matrix represents all 12 possibilities of P, I, R, and RI.
